ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must be low income or on a fixed income where social security is primary source of income or
- Have no insurance or are under insured.
- Must live in one of the following communities: Aurora, Batavia, Boulder Hill, Elburn, Geneva, North Aurora, Oswego, Sugar Grove or Yorkville.
- Current best corrected vision limits your ability to perform activities of daily living such as reading, driving, cooking and seeing faces or signs.

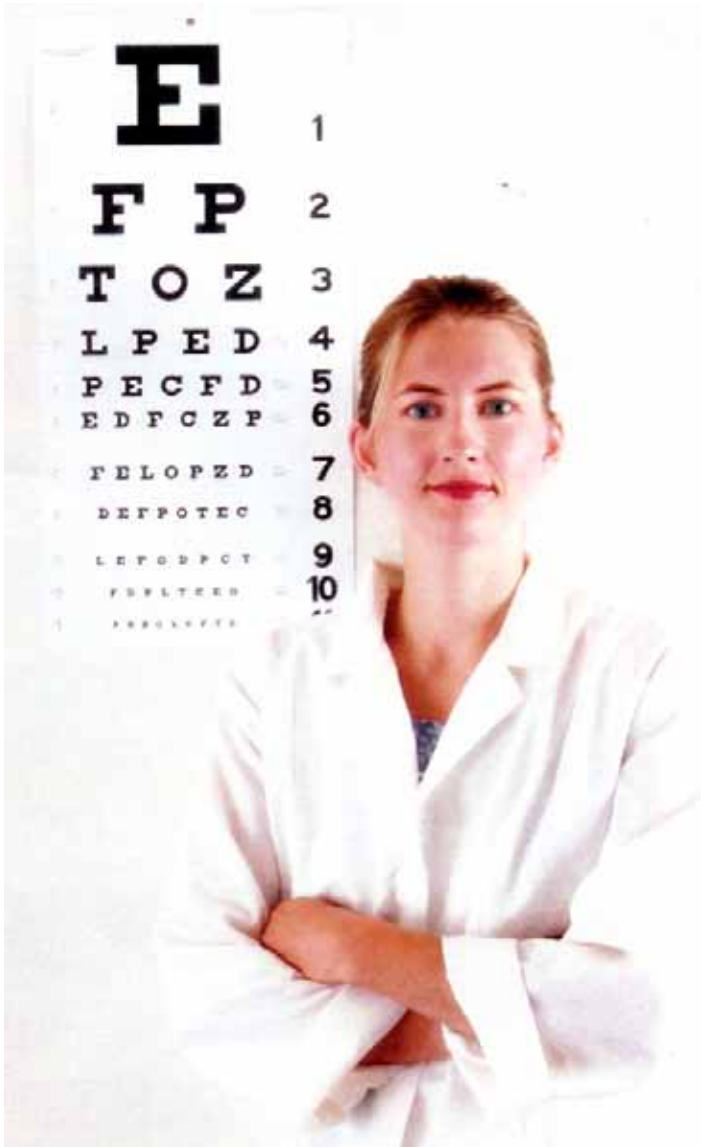
HOW TO SCHEDULE or QUESTIONS:

- Refer to Dunham low vision clinic at Painters District Council No.30 in Aurora.

THE PROGRAM:

- **Two visits** (1st – 2 hours) (2nd 1 to 1 ½ hours):
 - A low vision evaluation by a specially trained low vision eye doctor.
 - Counseling to assist with goal setting, and learning skills to cope with vision loss.
 - Instruction with a vision therapist to learn correct and efficient use of prescribed optical devices and low vision aids, information on resources, training in skills of daily living and technology.
- **Costs:**
 - The low vision evaluations are paid for by the **Dunham Foundation**.
 - Financial assistance is available to help with cost of devices that are prescribed.
